

AN ACT to amend the *Passengers Act* 1885.
 [2 November, 1934.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

- 1 This Act may be cited as the *Passengers Act* 1934.
- 2 The Principal Act is hereby amended—
- I. By deleting the words “for all purposes” in section one Section 1. thereof :
 - II. By expunging from section two thereof the definition of Section 2. collector and substituting therefor the following new definition :—

“ ‘Supervisor’ means a supervisor of passengers appointed under this Act : ” :

III. By deleting the words "of Tasmania" in section four thereof:

IV. By repealing section eleven thereof and substituting therefor the following new section eleven:—

"**11**—(1) The Governor may appoint such persons as he may think fit to be supervisors for the purposes of this Act.

"(2) It shall be the duty of every person so appointed to give effect to the provisions of this Act.":

V. By substituting the word—

(a) "Supervisor" for the word "collector": and

(b) "State" for the word "Colony"—

wherever occurring.
