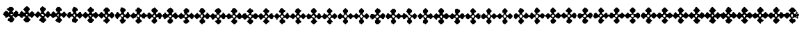

AN ACT to amend the *Pharmacy Act 1908*.
[21 December, 1939.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania,
by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative
Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled,
as follows:—

1 This Act may be cited as the *Pharmacy Act 1939*.

2 The Principal Act is hereby amended—Amendment

Section 21.

I. As to section twenty-one thereof—

- (a) By inserting “(1)” at the commencement:
- (b) By deleting the words “the intermediate” to “thereto” in the concluding part of the section and substituting therefor the words “such examination or test as may be prescribed”: and
- (c) By inserting (at the end) the following new subsection (2)—

“(2) Where an applicant for registration satisfies the Board that he has served as an apprentice to a pharmaceutical chemist registered in a State or country in which reciprocal provision in this regard is made, the Board may give him credit for the period so served as if the same had been service as an apprentice as required by paragraph III. of subsection (1) hereof.”:

II. As to section twenty-nine thereof by inserting—

- (a) “(1)” at the commencement:
- (b) “being an individual” after “unless” in the concluding general words of subsection (1):
- (c) “or, in the case of a corporation, one hundred pounds” after “imprisonment” at the end of subsection (1): and
- (d) “(2) No person shall conduct, or be the owner of, more than three pharmacies in this State at any one time.

Penalty: One hundred pounds or six months' imprisonment.

(3) No person shall—

- I. Vend any medicine or drug by means of any automatic machine or mechanical device for the delivery of goods to a customer without personal attendance on the part of the seller or any person on his behalf: or

II. Hawk any medicine or drug.

Penalty: Ten pounds.”

- (4) Upon the conviction of a corporation for any offence against this

section, every person who, at the time of the commission of the offence, was a director or officer of the corporation shall be deemed to be guilty of the offence, unless he proves that the offence was committed without his knowledge, or that he used all due diligence to prevent the commission of the offence." (at the end) : and

III. As to section thirty-eight thereof by inserting—

(a) " (1) " at the commencement: and

(b) " (2) In addition to any other matters which may be prescribed any such regulations may require any registered chemist to notify the Board as and when prescribed of the employment by him of any other registered chemist."
