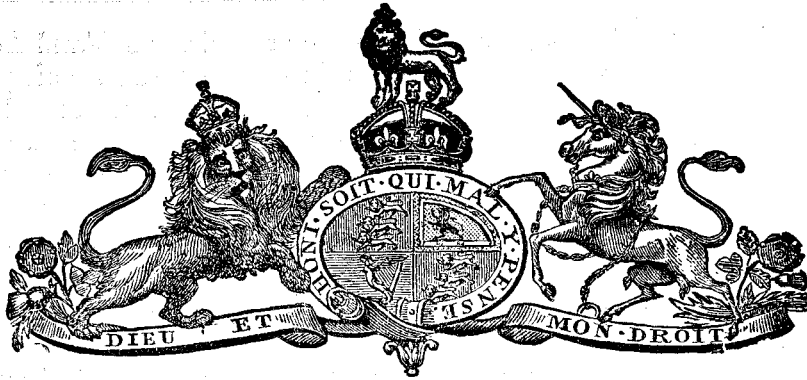

AN ACT to amend the *Plant Diseases Act 1930*.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

1 This Act may be cited as the *Plant Diseases Act 1935*.

- I. By inserting at the end of section ten thereof the following Section 10.
new subsections (4) and (5) :—

“(4) It shall be lawful for the Minister at the beginning of each financial year to pay to the Potato Marketing Board, out of the moneys standing to the credit of an account in

the Treasury called the Potato Diseases Fund Account, one halfpenny per bag or three-bushel case for all potatoes of the respective classes and an amount calculated at the prescribed rate or rates per bag or three-bushel case for all tomatoes, carrots, parsnips, and turnips in respect of which an inspection fee has been received by the Department of Agriculture in the preceding financial year, and thereupon—

i. The Treasurer shall issue and apply out of the said account such amount as the Minister shall certify to be payable to the said Board under this section : and

ii. The said Board shall apply all moneys received by it under this section for the purposes of dealing with the problem of marketing potatoes and any other vegetables produced in this State, and in furtherance of the objects for which the said Board was elected.

“(5) All inspection fees received by the said Department in respect of potatoes, tomatoes, carrots, parsnips, and turnips shall be paid into the said account, and, subject to the said payments thereon to the said Board, all expenses incurred by the said Department in respect of such inspection shall be defrayed out of that account.”
