AN ACT to amend the Police Offences Act 1935. 1943 [25 November, 1943.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

- 1 This Act may be cited as the Police Offences Act 1943. Short title.
- 2 Section fifteen of the Principal Act is hereby amended Amendment of 26 Geo. V. No. 44, s. 15.
 - I. "(1)" at the commencement: and
 - II. "(2) No person shall bathe or swim in the River Derwent at any place within one hundred and fifty yards of the Hobart Bridge.

Penalty: Twenty pounds." (at the end).
