

(b) by inserting after subsection (5) the following subsection:—

“ (5A) For the purposes of subsections (4) and (5) of this section—

I A conviction recorded against a person before the commencement of section three of the *Traffic Act (No. 2) 1957* under section forty-two of the *Police Offences Act 1935* in respect of the taking or use of a motor vehicle shall be deemed to be a conviction for an offence against subsection (1) of this section: and

II Where it is proved to the satisfaction of the police magistrate before whom a person is convicted of an offence against subsection (1) of this section that that person has previously been convicted elsewhere than in this State of the same offence or of a similar offence under any law relating to the unlawful taking, driving, or using of motor vehicles, the last-mentioned conviction shall be deemed to be a conviction for an offence against subsection (1) of this section,

and subsections (4) and (5) of this section shall be construed accordingly.”.

AN ACT to amend the *Public Service Act 1923*.
[3 July 1958.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1—(1) This Act may be cited as the *Public Service Act 1958*.

(2) The *Public Service Act 1923*, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

(3) Sections two and three of this Act shall commence on the first day of July 1958.

2 Section six of the Principal Act is amended by omitting subsection (7) thereof and substituting therefor the following subsections:—

missioner.

“ (7) The Commissioner shall be paid a salary at the rate of three thousand one hundred pounds a year.

“ (8) The salary of the Commissioner shall be paid out of the Consolidated Revenue which, to the necessary extent, is appropriated accordingly.

“ (9) No addition to, or deduction from, the salary payable pursuant to this section shall be made in order to meet variations in the cost of living.”.

3 Section nineteen of the Principal Act is amended by inserting in subsection (6) thereof, after the word “ Board ”, the words “ (other than the Commissioner) ”.

4 Notwithstanding anything in the Principal Act, as amended by the foregoing provisions of this Act, during the period commencing on the first day of July 1957 and ending on the thirtieth day of June 1958 the Commissioner shall be paid a salary at the rate of two thousand nine hundred pounds a year.
