

PUBLIC SERVICE.

No. 13 of 1959.

AN ACT to amend the *Public Service Act 1923*.
[6 August 1959.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1—(1) This Act may be cited as the *Public Service Act 1959*. Short title, citation, and commencement.

(2) The *Public Service Act 1923*, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

(3) This Act shall be deemed to have commenced on the first day of July 1958.

2 Section six of the Principal Act is amended by omitting from subsection (7) thereof the word “one” and substituting therefor the word “four”. Appointment &c., of Commissioner.
