AN ACT to amend the *Public Service Act* 1923. [6 August 1959.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

- 1—(1) This Act may be cited as the Public Service Act Short title, citation, an commence-
- (2) The *Public Service* Act 1923, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.
- (3) This Act shall be deemed to have commenced on the first day of July 1958.
- 2 Section six of the Principal Act is amended by omitting Appointment from subsection (7) thereof the word "one" and substituting missioner. therefor the word "four".
