AN ACT to amend the *Penguin Water Act* 1908. A.D. 1940.
[27 June, 1940.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 This Act may be cited as the *Penguin Water Act* 1940. Short title.

Power to

2 It shall be lawful for the Council, in addition to any moneys borrowed under or for the purposes of the Principal Act, to borrow any sums of money not exceeding in the whole the sum of four thousand five hundred pounds for the purposes of the Principal Act, and the repayment of any moneys borrowed thereunder, and for defraying the expenses of, and incidental to, the extension, carrying out, and completion of all or any of the works authorised by the Principal Act, and of the preparation, passing, and carrying out of this Act.

Mode of
borrowing.

3 All moneys raised or borrowed under this Act shall be subject to the provisions of the Principal Act in the same manner as if such moneys had been raised or borrowed under that Act, but section sixteen of the Principal Act shall not apply to the borrowing of any such moneys.
