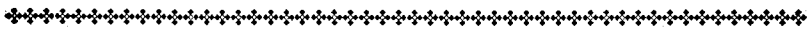

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AN ACT to provide for the Execution of certain  
Public Works. [25 November, 1943.]

**B**E it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

**1** This Act may be cited as the *Public Works Execution Act* (No. 2) 1943. Short title.

## PUBLIC WORKS GENERALLY.

**2** The Minister for Lands and Works may cause the works specified in parts I. and II. of the first schedule to be undertaken and executed at a cost not exceeding in each case the amount set forth in those parts of that schedule in respect of each work.

**3** The Treasurer, for the purpose of defraying the cost of the works authorised by section two, may raise, borrow, and receive any sums of money not exceeding in the whole the sum of sixty-six thousand and ninety-six pounds ten shillings.

**4** The first schedule to the *Public Works Execution Act* 1942 is hereby amended by inserting the words "and garage" after the word "Transport" in item 12 thereof.

**5** If any part of the moneys provided by this part is not required for the purpose of the work for which it was so provided, the Minister may expend the whole or any part of any such unexpended balance which does not exceed fifty pounds upon any other work which has been authorised by Parliament in respect of the same city or municipality in respect of which the amount was originally provided.

**6** The Treasurer may raise, borrow, and receive any sums of money, not exceeding in the whole the sum of two hundred and thirty-four thousand pounds, and apply the same, in accordance with the provisions of the *Transport Act* 1938, by way of capital expenditure in connection with the transport undertaking, as set forth in the second schedule.

## STATE HYDRO-ELECTRIC WORKS.

**7** The Treasurer may raise, borrow, and receive any sums of money, not exceeding in the whole the sum of five hundred thousand pounds, and apply the same in accordance with the provisions of the *Hydro-Electric Commission Act 1929* in defraying the cost of the execution of the works specified in the third schedule.

**8** The construction by the Hydro-Electric Commission of the works referred to in the third schedule is hereby authorised.

AND BALANCES.

**9** The Treasurer may reappropriate the several sums specified in the fourth schedule, being the unexpended balances of the amounts appropriated for the items set forth in that schedule, and apply the same in and towards defraying the cost of the execution of the works authorised by this Act.
