## RADIOACTIVE SUBSTANCES.

---

No. 3 of 1957.

AN ACT to amend the *Radioactive Substances Act 1954*. [3 April 1957.]

**B**E it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

Short title  
and citation.

**1**—(1) This Act may be cited as the *Radioactive Substances Act 1957*.

(2) The *Radioactive Substances Act 1954* is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

Interpreta-  
tion.

**2** Section two of the Principal Act is amended by inserting after the definition of "radioactive substance" the following definitions:—

“‘radiographer’ means a person who is a radiographer as defined in the articles of association of the body known as the Australasian Institute of Radiography;

“‘registered veterinary surgeon’ means a registered veterinary surgeon as defined in the *Veterinary Act 1918*”;

Exemptions.

**3** Section six of the Principal Act is amended—

(a) by omitting from subsection (1) the words "or a certified dentist" and substituting therefor the words "a certified dentist, or a radiographer";

- (b) by omitting from subsection (2) the word "This" and substituting therefor the words "Subsection (1) of this", and by omitting from that subsection the words "or certified dentist" and substituting therefor the words ", a certified dentist, or a radiographer"; and
- (c) by adding at the end thereof the following subsections:—

"(3) A registered veterinary surgeon who uses any irradiating apparatus for the purpose only of diagnosing diseases of any member of the animal kingdom (other than a human being) is not required to be the holder of a licence.

"(4) Subsection (3) of this section does not apply to a registered veterinary surgeon who uses any irradiating apparatus for the purpose of treating an animal."

## NURSES' REGISTRATION.

No. 4 of 1957.

AN ACT to amend the *Nurses' Registration Act* 1952. [3 April 1957.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

**1**—(1) This Act may be cited as the *Nurses' Registration Act* 1957. Short title and citation.

(2) The *Nurses' Registration Act* 1952, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

**2** Section ten of the Principal Act is amended by omitting from subsection (3) thereof the word "twenty-one" and substituting therefor the word "twenty". Registration of nurses.
