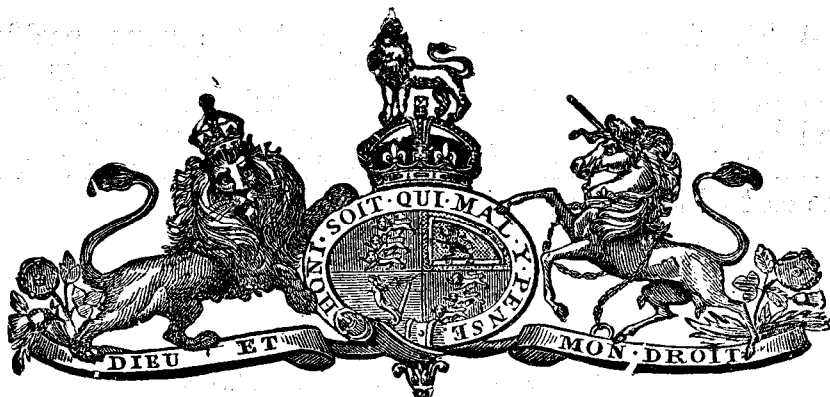

ANALYSIS.

1. Short title.
2. Power to Minister to undertake works.
3. Power to Treasurer to reappropriate £7518.

AN ACT to provide for the Execution of certain Works in connection with the State Railways. [17 December, 1935.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 This Act may be cited as the *Railway Works Execution Act 1935*. Short title.

2 The Minister may cause the works specified in the first and second schedules to be undertaken and executed at a cost not exceeding in each case the amount specified in those schedules in respect thereof. Power to Minister to undertake works.

3 The Treasurer may reappropriate the sums specified in the third schedule, being the unexpended balances of the amounts appropriated for the items set forth in that schedule, and apply the aggregate thereof, amounting to the sum of seven thousand five hundred and eighteen pounds, in defraying the cost of the works authorised by this Act.
