#### ANALYSIS.

AN ACT to provide for the Execution of 1935. certain Works in connection with the State [17 December, 1935.] Railways.

**B**E it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:-

- 1 This Act may be cited as the Railway Works Execution Short title. Act 1935.
- 2 The Minister may cause the works specified in the first Power to and second schedules to be undertaken and executed at a cost undertake not exceeding in each case the amount specified in those works.

Power to Treasurer to reappropriate £7518. 3 The Treasurer may reappropriate the sums specified in the third schedule, being the unexpended balances of the amounts appropriated for the items set forth in that schedule, and apply the aggregate thereof, amounting to the sum of seven thousand five hundred and eighteen pounds, in defraying the cost of the works authorised by this Act.
