AN ACT to amend the *Statutory Authorities Administration Act 1937*. [17 December, 1940.] A.D.  
1940.

**B**E it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

**1** This Act may be cited as the *Statutory Authorities Administration Act 1940*. Short title.

**2** The Principal Act is hereby amended by inserting after section eight thereof the following new sections nine and ten—

“**9**—(1) Where in any city or municipality—

- I. A poll has been held in pursuance of the provisions of the Act under which the local government of such city or municipality is administered: and
- II. A majority of the electors voting at such poll has determined that the city or municipality shall be governed by a commission—

the Governor by proclamation may appoint a commission for that purpose.

(2) Every such commission shall consist of three persons of whom one shall be appointed as chairman of the commission.

(3) Every such commission shall continue until a council is elected in pursuance of a determination by the electors at a subsequent poll that the city or municipality shall be governed by a council and such council has taken office; and thereupon the appointment of the commission shall be revoked by proclamation.

(4) The provisions of sections four and five and of subsection (2) of section six shall apply to every such commission and the members thereof.

“**10** Every commission appointed under this Act shall bear a name consisting of the place name of the relevant city or municipality followed by the word “City” or “Municipality” as the case may be and the word “Commission.”
