9 Section thirty-nine of the Principal Act is amended by omitting therefrom the word "grade" and substituting therefor the word "kind". Registrations under previous Act.

10 Section forty-five of the Principal Act is amended by omitting from paragraph IV thereof the word "grade" and substituting therefor the word "kind". By-laws.

11 Section forty-six of the Principal Act is amended by omitting therefrom the word "grade" (wherever occurring) and substituting therefor, in each case, the word "kind". Offences.

12 Section forty-seven of the Principal Act is amended by omitting from paragraph I of subsection (1) thereof the word "secondary" and substituting therefor the word "post-primary". Regulations.

TRAFFIC.

No. 16 of 1958.

AN ACT to amend the *Traffic Act 1925*.

[3 July 1958.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1—(1) This Act may be cited as the *Traffic Act 1958*.

(2) The *Traffic Act 1925*, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act. Short title and citation.

2 Section thirty-seven of the Principal Act is amended— Unauthorized use of motor vehicle.

(a) by inserting after subsection (2) thereof the following subsection:—

“ (2A) The provisions of section fifty-five of the *Police Offences Act 1935* extend and apply where a person is found offending (within the meaning of that section) against subsection (1) of this section.”; and

(b) by inserting after subsection (5) the following subsection:—

“ (5A) For the purposes of subsections (4) and (5) of this section—

I A conviction recorded against a person before the commencement of section three of the *Traffic Act (No. 2) 1957* under section forty-two of the *Police Offences Act 1935* in respect of the taking or use of a motor vehicle shall be deemed to be a conviction for an offence against subsection (1) of this section: and

II Where it is proved to the satisfaction of the police magistrate before whom a person is convicted of an offence against subsection (1) of this section that that person has previously been convicted elsewhere than in this State of the same offence or of a similar offence under any law relating to the unlawful taking, driving, or using of motor vehicles, the last-mentioned conviction shall be deemed to be a conviction for an offence against subsection (1) of this section,

and subsections (4) and (5) of this section shall be construed accordingly.”.

PUBLIC SERVICE.

No. 17 of 1958.

AN ACT to amend the *Public Service Act 1923*.
[3 July 1958.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

Short title,
citation, and
commence-
ment.

1—(1) This Act may be cited as the *Public Service Act 1958*.

(2) The *Public Service Act 1923*, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

(3) Sections two and three of this Act shall commence on the first day of July 1958.
