### No. 16 of 1958.

# AN ACT to amend the *Traffic Act* 1925. [3 July 1958.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

- 1—(1) This Act may be cited as the Traffic Act 1958.
- Short title and citation.
- (2) The Traffic Act 1925, as subsequently amended, is in and citation this Act referred to as the Principal Act.
  - 2 Section thirty-seven of the Principal Act is amended— Unauthorized

    (a) by inserting after subsection (2) thereof the fol-vehicle.

    lowing subsection:—
    - "(2A) The provisions of section fifty-five of the *Police Offences Act* 1935 extend and apply where a person is found offending (within the meaning of that section) against subsection (1) of this section."; and

- (b) by inserting after subsection (5) the following subsection:—
  - "(5A) For the purposes of subsections (4) and (5) of this section—
    - I A conviction recorded against a person before the commencement of section three of the *Traffic Act (No. 2)* 1957 under section forty-two of the *Police Offences Act* 1935 in respect of the taking or use of a motor vehicle shall be deemed to be a conviction for an offence against subsection (1) of this section: and
    - II Where it is proved to the satisfaction of the police magistrate before whom a person is convicted of an offence against subsection (1) of this section that that person has previously been convicted elsewhere than in this State of the same offence or of a similar offence under any law relating to the unlawful taking, driving, or using of motor vehicles, the lastmentioned conviction shall be deemed to be a conviction for an offence against subsection (1) of this section,

and subsections (4) and (5) of this section shall be construed accordingly.".

## No. 17 of 1958.

AN ACT to amend the *Public Service Act* 1923. [3 July 1958.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

Short title, citation, and commencement.

- 1—(1) This Act may be cited as the *Public Service Act* 1958.
- (2) The *Public Service Act* 1923, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.
- (3) Sections two and three of this Act shall commence on the first day of July 1958.
