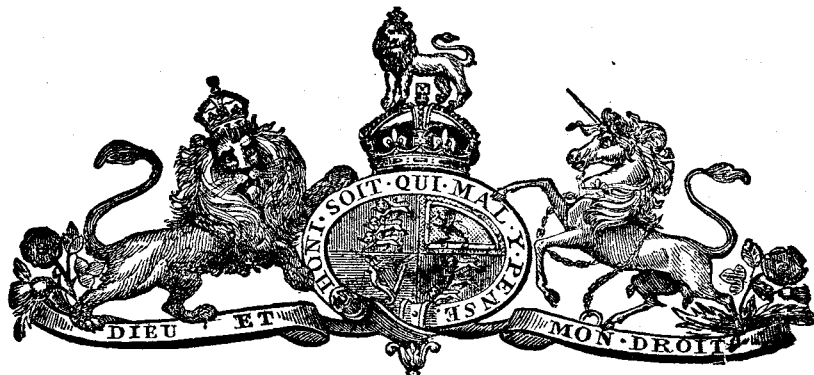

2 The Treasurer may issue out of the Consolidated Revenue, and apply towards making good the supply hereby granted to His Majesty for the service of the year ending the thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and thirty-four, the sum of Seven hundred and ten thousand six hundred and sixty-nine Pounds Thirteen Shillings and Sixpence.

3 All sums granted by this Act, and the Supply Act, 1933-34, and the Supply Act (No. 2), 1933-34, out of the Consolidated Revenue towards making good the supply granted to His Majesty, amounting, as appears by the First Schedule to this Act, in the aggregate to the sum of One million three hundred and sixty-three thousand and forty-nine Pounds Thirteen Shillings and Sixpence, are appropriated, and shall be deemed to have been appropriated as from the date of the passing of those Acts for the purposes and services expressed in the Second Schedule to this Act.
