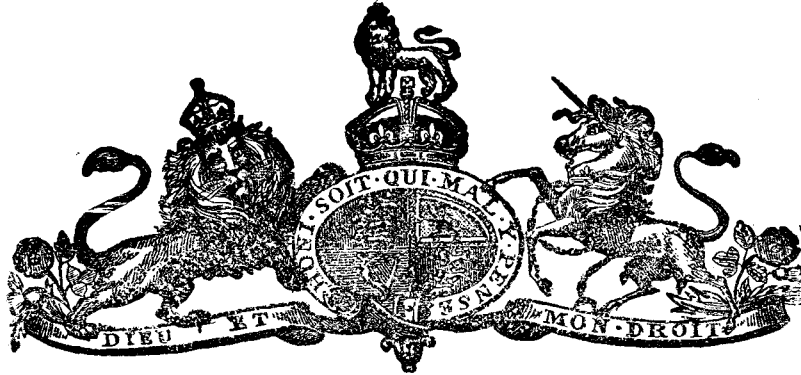

- 1. Short title.
- 2. Repeal of Subsection (2) of Section 8 of "The Contagious Diseases (Cattle) Act, 1901," and substitution of new subsection.

AN ACT to amend "The Contagious Diseases (Cattle) Act, 1901." A.D. 1924.
[31 March, 1924.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

1 This Act may be cited as "The Contagious Diseases (Cattle) Act, 1924." Short title.

2 Subsection (2) of Section Eight of "The Contagious Diseases (Cattle) Act, 1901," is hereby repealed and the following subsection substituted therefor :—

"(2) The minimum contribution to be paid by any cattle-owner under this section shall, notwithstanding anything hereinbefore contained to the contrary, be One Shilling per annum."
