

# AN ACT to further amend the Campbell 1928. Town Water Act, 1878. [7 January, 1929.]

WHEREAS it is expedient to further amend the Campbell Town PREAMBLE. Water Act, 1878:

Be it therefore enacted by H<sub>1</sub>s Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 This Act may be cited as "The Campbell Town Water Act Short title. Amendment Act, 1928."

#### Campbell Town Water Act Amendment.

A.D. 1928.

2 In this Act the expression "the said Act" means the Campbell Town Water Act, 1878.

Interpretation.

Amendment of 42 Vict. No. 20.

3 Section Fifteen of the said Act is hereby amended by inserting, after the words "fishing in the said River" in the ninth line thereof, the following words:—

"To make charges for water of the said river or any stream flowing into the said river supplied and used for irrigation or other purposes:

To impose penalties for breaches of any of the said by-laws."

Acts to be read together.

4 This Act and the said Act, and every other Act amending the said Act, shall be read and construed together as one Act.
