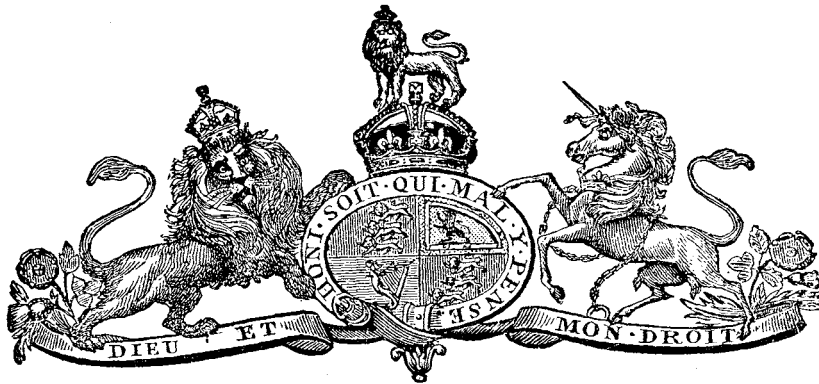

AN ACT to amend "The Lotteries Act, ^{A.D.} 1878." [31 March, 1924.] 1924.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

1 This Act may be cited as "The Lotteries Act (No. 2), 1924." Short title.

2 Section Four of “The Lotteries Amendment Act, 1899” inserted by “The Lotteries Amendment Act, 1917” is hereby amended by inserting after Subsection (8) thereof the following new Subsection (9)—

“(9) The Commissioner may, once in each racing year, grant to the Committee of a registered horse-racing club which usually holds its race meetings on a racecourse outside a city area, a licence to use the totalisator on a registered racecourse within a city area, although the maximum number of racing days specified in Paragraph 1. of Subsection (2) hereof is thereby exceeded, but any licence so granted shall be in lieu of a licence which might have been granted to such committee for the use of the totalisator upon such racecourse as aforesaid outside a city area, and the number of licences which may be granted in respect of that racecourse shall be reduced accordingly.”
