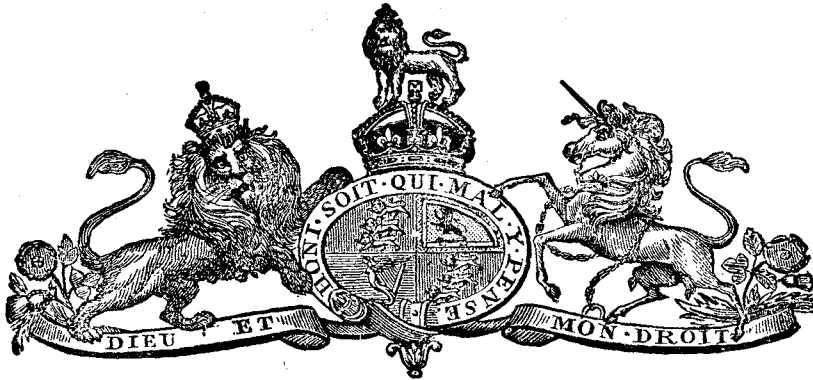

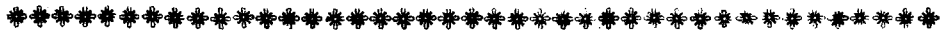

ANALYSIS.

1. Short title and incorporation with 6 Ed. VII. No. 31.

AN ACT to further amend "The Local Government Act, 1906." [14 January, 1919.] ^{A.D.} 1918.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

1 This Act may be cited as "The Local Government Amendment Act, 1918," and shall be read and construed as one with "The Local Government Act, 1906," and its amendments.

2 Section Two hundred and five of "The Local Government Act, 1906," is hereby amended—

i. As to Paragraph XII. of Subsection Ten thereof by inserting the words "and collecting," immediately after the word "imposing," occurring in the Second line of the said paragraph: and

ii. By inserting after Paragraph XII. aforesaid the following new paragraph:—

"XIIA. Imposing and collecting a toll upon vehicles (other than cars used on railways or tramways) passing over any road and carrying timber, other than timber delivered by tradesmen for use within the municipality; provided that such toll shall not exceed Two Shillings and Sixpence for every One thousand superficial feet of timber so carried in or upon such vehicle."

3 Notwithstanding anything in any Act it shall be taken and deemed to be lawful for the council of any municipality (in addition to the expenditure of any sum or sums not exceeding in the whole the sum of Twenty-five Pounds as provided by Section One hundred and thirteen of "The Local Government Act, 1906,") to have applied and to apply out of the municipal fund of the municipality any further sum or sums of money approved by the council (not exceeding in the whole the sum of Fifty Pounds) in connection with celebrations in Tasmania on the occasion of the signing of the armistice between the Allies and Germany, and any future celebrations on the occasion of the declaration of peace.
