AN ACT to amend "The Leven Harbour Trust Act." A.D. 1923.
[9 November, 1923.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 This Act may be cited as "The Leven Harbour Trust Act, 1923." Short title.

2 It shall be lawful for the trustees to borrow under and subject to the provisions of "The State Loans to Local Bodies Act, 1921," any sum or sums of money, not exceeding in the whole the sum of Three thousand Pounds, for all or any of the purposes set forth in the schedule to this Act. Power to trustees to borrow £3000. 12 Geo. V. No. 23.

Sinking fund.

3 The amount payable by the trustees as an annual contribution towards a sinking fund, in respect of any moneys borrowed under this Act, shall be a sum equal to One Pound Ten Shillings per centum of the moneys so borrowed.

Power to Treas-
urer to raise
£3000

4 It shall be lawful for the Treasurer to borrow, raise, and receive, for the purposes of this Act, a sum not exceeding Three thousand Pounds.

SCHEDULE.

The erection and construction of wharf extensions.
The erection and construction of offices and sheds.
The erection and construction of a retaining wall at West Ulverstone.
The payment of costs and expenses incidental to the above.
