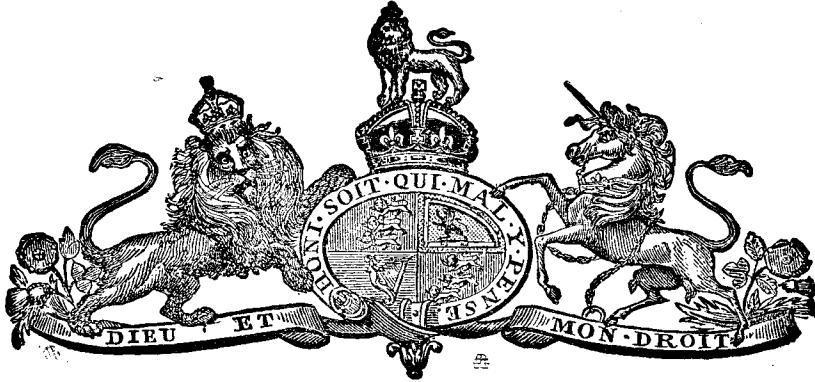

- 2. Amendment of Section 6 of "The Motor Vehicles Tax Act, 1917."

AN ACT to amend "The Motor Vehicles Tax Act, 1917." [18 March, 1924.]

A.D. 1924.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 This Act may be cited as "The Motor Vehicles Tax Act, 1924." Short title.

2 Section Six of "The Motor Vehicles Tax Act, 1917" is hereby amended by expunging Subsection (4) thereof, and substituting the following new Subsection (4) therefor:—

Amendment of Section 6 of "The Motor Vehicles Tax Act, 1917" (8 Geo. V. No.30)

"(4) The provisions of this section shall not apply in respect of any motor vehicle used or intended to be used in Tasmania for the purpose of hire, or for carrying passengers or goods directly or indirectly for gain or reward, or for the purpose of any trade or business."
