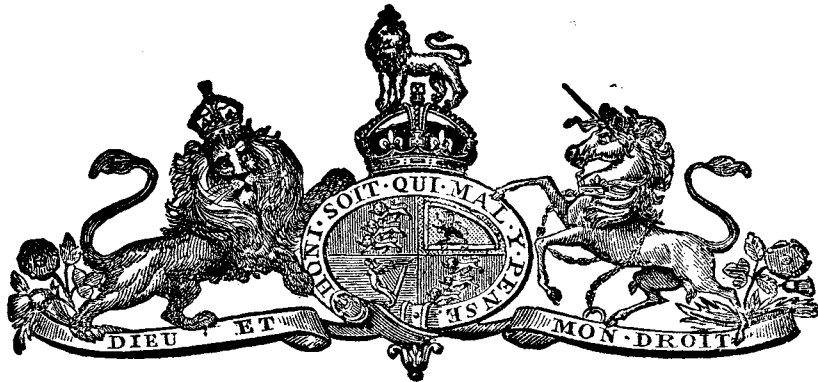

AN ACT to provide for the Execution of ^{A.D.} 1915.
certain Public Works, and for other purposes.
[29 January, 1916.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

1 This Act may be cited for all purposes as “The Public Works Short title, Execution Act (No. 2), 1915.”

Public Works Execution (No. 2).

A.D. 1915.
Interpretation.

2 In this Act, unless the context otherwise determines, "the Minister" means the Minister of Lands and Works for the time being, and includes any person appointed by him or acting under his orders.

Minister to cause works to be constructed.

3 It shall be lawful for the Minister to cause to be constructed, improved, executed, or completed, the works specified in the schedule to this Act at a cost for each separate work not exceeding the amounts set forth in the said schedule.

Appropriation for works in schedule.

4 The cost of the several works specified in the schedule to this Act shall be defrayed out of moneys to be provided by Parliament for that purpose.

Money not required for work may be expended by Minister on other works.

5 If the Minister at any time reports to the Governor that the whole or any portion of the money voted by this Act or any previous Act providing for the execution of public works is not required to be expended upon the work for which such money is voted it shall be lawful for the Minister to expend such balance, provided it does not exceed Fifty Pounds, upon such other work or works previously authorised by Parliament as he may think fit: Provided that such lastmentioned work is situated in the same city or municipality, as the case may be, as the work for which such money was originally voted.

Provisions of 44 Vict. No. 32 and 45 Vict. No. 31 to be applicable.

6 All the provisions contained in "The Public Works Construction Act, 1880." and "The Branch Roads Construction Act, 1881," shall extend and apply to the works mentioned in the schedule to this Act, as fully in all respects as if the said provisions had been incorporated in this Act.

Amendment to schedule to 4 Geo. V. No. 14, as to Item 1052.

7—(1) Schedule (1) to "The Public Works Execution Act, 1913," is hereby amended as from the commencement of that Act, in regard to Item One thousand and fifty-two, by omitting from that item the words "(conditionally that local authority provides for payment of half interest and sinking fund,)" and substituting therefor the words "(conditionally that the North-Eastern Harbour Trustees contribute a like sum of Two thousand five hundred Pounds towards the work.)"

(2) Notwithstanding anything to the contrary contained in "The North-Eastern Harbour Trust Act, 1913," it shall be lawful for the North-Eastern Harbour Trustees to contribute the said sum of Two thousand five hundred Pounds and also if they think fit a further sum not exceeding Three hundred Pounds towards the work specified in Item One thousand and fifty-two aforesaid, out of moneys borrowed by them or any other funds at their disposal and to pay the same to the Minister for Lands and Works for expenditure by him for the said purpose.

Public Works Execution (No. 2).

8 The schedule to "The Public Works Execution Act (No. 3), 1914," is hereby amended in regard to Item One thousand one hundred and sixty-four by inserting after the word, "Seymour," the words, "or within Twenty miles thereof."

9 It shall be lawful for the Minister to expend the sum of Three hundred Pounds appropriated for Item Six hundred and ninety-four of the schedule to the Act 4 Georgii V. No. 14 in or towards the construction, execution, and completion of the following road, "Andover Road to Nala Siding;" and it shall be lawful for the Treasurer to reappropriate the same accordingly.
