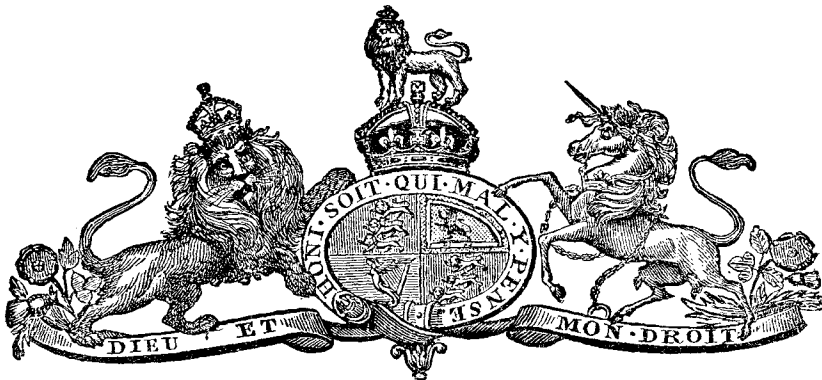

AN ACT to amend "The Scottsdale Lighting Act, 1920." A.D. 1923.  
[9 November, 1923.]

**BE** it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

**1** This Act may be cited as "The Scottsdale Lighting Act, 1923." Short title.

**2** The Council is hereby authorised to charge all amounts of interest and sinking fund, accrued up to the First day of March, One thousand nine hundred and twenty-three, in respect of moneys borrowed under the authority of "The Scottsdale Lighting Act, 1920," against the principal moneys so borrowed. Council may pay certain interest and sinking fund out of loan.
