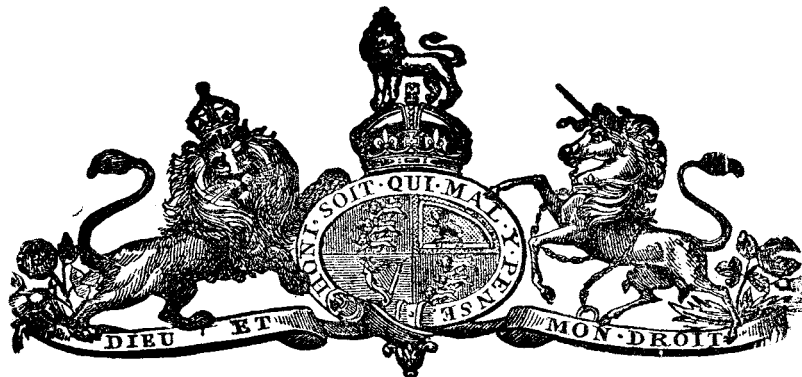

AN ACT to provide for the Execution of <sup>A.D.</sup> 1928.  
 certain Works in connection with the  
 Provision by the State of Accommodation  
 Houses for Tourists. [15 January, 1929.]

**B**E it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

**1** This Act may be cited as “The State Tourists’ Accommodation Houses Execution Act, 1928.” Short title.

*State Tourists' Accommodation Houses Execution.*

A.D. 1928.

Interpretation.

Minister may cause to be constructed the works specified in the schedule

Provisions of 44 Vict. No. 32 to be applicable.

Land required may be acquired under 1 Geo. V. No. 11 at option of Minister.

Treasurer authorised to borrow £2050.

**2** "Minister" means the Minister for Railways.

**3** It shall be lawful for the Minister to cause to be constructed, improved, executed, completed, and carried out the works specified in the schedule to this Act, at a cost for each separate work not exceeding the amount set forth in the said schedule in respect thereof.

**4** The provisions of the Public Works Construction Act, 1880, shall extend and apply to the works mentioned in the schedules to this Act as fully in all respects as if the said provisions had been incorporated in this Act.

**5** Notwithstanding anything contained in this or any other Act, any land required for the purpose of any public work authorised by this Act may, at the option of the Minister, be purchased, acquired, or taken under the Lands Resumption Act, 1910, and in the event of such option being exercised the provisions of such Act shall be deemed to be incorporated with this Act, in lieu of the provisions of the Public Works Construction Act, 1880.

**6** It shall be lawful for the Treasurer to raise, borrow, and receive a total sum not exceeding Two thousand and fifty Pounds for the purposes of this Act.
