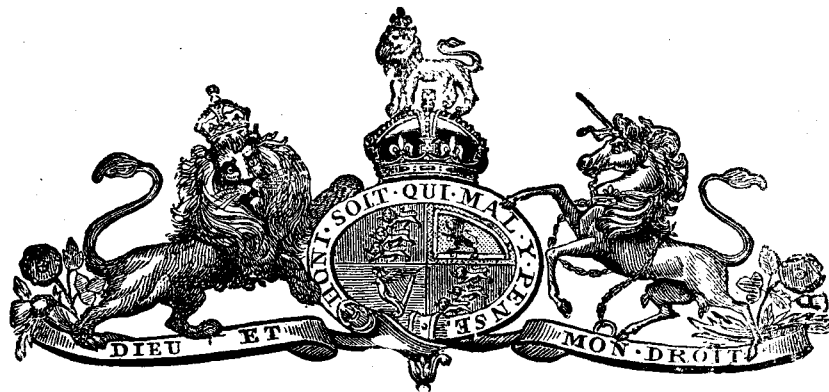

AN ACT to further amend "The Trustee Act, 1898," and for other purposes. A.D. 1916.  
[3 November, 1916.]

**BE** it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

**1** This Act may be cited as "The Trustee Act, 1916," and shall be read as one with "The Trustee Act, 1898," and every amendment thereof.

2---(1) Section Five of "The Trustee Act, 1898," is amended by inserting after Subdivision x. thereof, the following subdivision:—

"xi. In any debentures, stock, or securities of the Government or the Parliament of the Commonwealth of Australia:"

(2) The power to invest conferred on a trustee by virtue of the foregoing amendment, is hereby declared to be exercisable by trustees of trusts created either before or after the establishment of the said Commonwealth.

(3) This Act shall be deemed to have been passed on the Twenty-third day of July, One thousand nine hundred and fifteen, and to have been operative as from that date.
