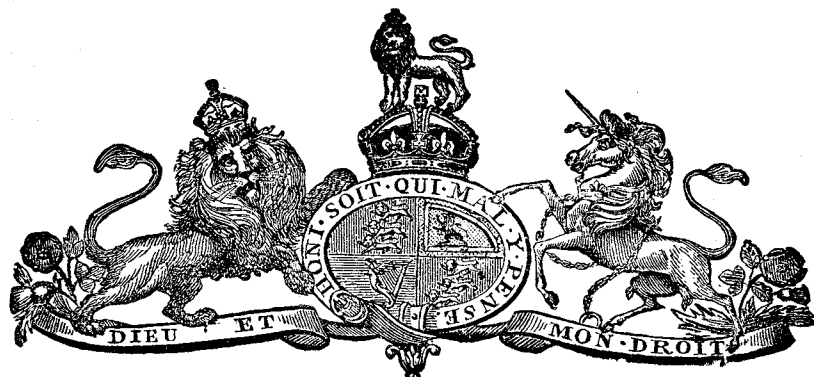

AN ACT to provide for the Application of the Moneys Granted by the Commonwealth to this State for Payment to Wheat Growers ; and to amend the *Wheat Growers Relief Act* 1934 and the *Flour Tax Relief Act* 1934.

[19 August, 1935.]

WHEREAS by section six A of the *Wheat Growers Relief Act* 1934-1935 of the Commonwealth it is enacted that the sum of five thousand two hundred and fifty pounds shall be granted by the Commonwealth by way of financial assistance to this State, and that that sum shall be so granted upon condition that it is used by the State for the payment to wheat growers as provided by the Commonwealth Act:

Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

Short title.

1 This Act may be cited as the *Wheat Growers Relief Act 1935*.

Interpretation.

2 In this Act—

“The Commonwealth Act” means the *Wheat Growers Relief Act 1934-1935* of the Commonwealth:

“The Suspense Account” means the account kept pursuant to section three.

Wheat Growers Relief (Necessitous Cases) Suspense Account, 1935.

3—(1) Upon the commencement of this Act, there shall be opened and kept in the books of the Treasury an account to be called “The Wheat Growers Relief (Necessitous Cases) Suspense Account, 1935.”

(2) There shall be paid and credited to the Suspense Account all moneys received by this State under the provisions of section **6A** of the Commonwealth Act.

Application of moneys.

4 The amount standing to the credit of the Suspense Account shall be paid by the Treasurer to wheat growers, as may be prescribed, upon the certificate of the Director of Agriculture, and in accordance with the provisions of the Commonwealth Act and the regulations thereunder.

Regulations.

5 The Governor may make regulations for the purposes of this Act.

Amendment of 25 Geo. V No. 88. Preamble.

6 The *Wheat Growers Relief Act 1934* is hereby amended as from the commencement thereof—

I. As to the preamble thereof—

- (a) By inserting the words “section four of” after the word “by” in the first line thereof:
- (b) By deleting the words “the sum of three thousand pounds” in the second and third lines thereof and substituting therefor the words “certain moneys”:
- (c) By deleting the words “that sum” in the fourth line thereof and substituting therefor the words “such moneys”:
- (d) By deleting the words “it is” in the fifth line thereof and substituting therefor the words “they are”:

II. By inserting after the word "of" in the second line of subsection (2) of section three thereof the words "section four of." Section 3. A.D. 1935.

7 The *Flour Tax Relief Act* 1934 is hereby amended, as from the commencement thereof, by inserting the words "section nine of" after the words "provisions of" in the third line of subsection (2) of section three thereof.
