A BILL

to appropriate moneys out of the Consolidated Fund for recurrent services and for certain works and services for the Parliament for the financial year 1995–96 and to appropriate the supplies granted for recurrent services and for certain works and services under the **Appropriation (Parliament) (Interim 1995–96) Act 1995** and for other purposes.

Appropriation (Parliament 1995–96, No. 1) Act 1995

The Parliament of Victoria enacts as follows:

1. Purpose

5

The purpose of this Act is to appropriate certain sums and supplies.

2. Commencement

This Act comes into operation on the day on which it receives the Royal Assent.

Section headings appear in bold italics and are not part of the Act. (See Interpretation of Legislation Act 1984.)

3. Definition

In this Act--

"works" means the construction, replacement, renovation, renewal, protection, development or surveying of, alterations or improvements to buildings, structures, or other properties, the purchase of land, buildings or property and the provision, alteration or improvement of furniture, fittings, plant, machinery, equipment, tools and vehicles and expenditure incidental to those activities.

4. Application of moneys

(1) The Treasurer may issue out of the Consolidated Fund in respect of the financial year 1995–96 the sum of thirty million and thirty-eight thousand and seven hundred dollars as set out in Schedule 1 for recurrent services and works and services.

- (2) If—
 - (a) during the financial year 1995–96 the amount payable in respect of salaries is increased as the result of any act or determination; and

(b) the relevant amount specified in Schedule 1 under the heading "Recurrent" is insufficient to provide for the payment of the increased amount payable in respect of salaries—

the Treasurer may issue out of the Consolidated Fund and apply such amounts not exceeding in total the increased amount payable in respect of salaries and any such amounts shall be and be deemed to be appropriated in and towards the service of the financial year 1995–96 in addition to any other appropriation made by this Act.

- (3) In sub-section (2)—
 - "salaries" includes wages or other payments in the nature of salary, payments by way of overtime or penalty rates or in lieu of long service leave or for retiring gratuities;

"determination" includes any regulation or any award order or determination of a person or body authorised to determine minimum salaries or wages under any law of the Commonwealth or of the State

5. Appropriation (Parliament) (Interim 1995–96) Act 1995 to cease

On and from the commencement of this Act, the Appropriation (Parliament) (Interim 1995–96) Act 1995 shall cease to have effect and shall not authorise the issue and application of any moneys out of the Consolidated Fund after that commencement.
