for

An Act to amend the *Anzac Day Act 1958* and the *Theatres Act 1958* and for other purposes.

Anzac Day (Amendment) Act 1987

The Parliament of Victoria enacts as follows:

Purpose.

1. The purpose of this Act is to amend the *Anzac Day Act 1958* and the *Theatres Act 1958* to enable sports meetings, films and theatrical entertainment to commence at 1.00 p.m. on Anzac Day.

Commencement.

2. This Act comes into operation on the day on which it receives the Royal Assent.

Amendment of Anzac Day Act.

3. The *Anzac Day Act 1958* is amended as follows:
- (a) In section 4 (2), for “two” substitute “one”;
 - (b) In section 5 (1) (a) and (b), for “one-thirty” substitute “one”.
