To repeal section 7A of the *Bank Holidays Act* 1958 and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Victoria in this present Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows (that is to say):

Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the Bank Holidays (Amendment) Act 1985.

Commencement.

2. This Act shall come into operation on the 28th day after the day on which it receives the Royal Assent.

Principal Act.

3. In this Act, the *Bank Holidays Act* 1958 is called the Principal Act.
