An Act to amend the Chiropodists Act 1968 and for other purposes

Chiropodists (Amendment) Act 1989

The Parliament of Victoria enacts as follows:

Purpose

1. The purpose of this Act is to make a number of miscellaneous amendments to the *Chiropodists Act* 1968.

5 Commencement

2. This Act comes into operation on a day or days to be proclaimed.

Remuneration of Board members

- 3. After section 5 (5) of the Chiropodists Act 1968 insert—
 - "(6) Each member of the Board is entitled to receive such fees and allowances as are fixed from time to time by the Governor in Council."

Board to consult with Chief General Manager of Health Department

- 4. After section 7 (1) of the Chiropodists Act 1968 insert—
 - "(1A) In exercising its powers of performing its duties, the Board shall from time to time consult the Chief General Manager of the Department of Health in regard to the existing and proposed activities of the Board and shall have regard to the Chief General Manager's advice."

Qualification for registration

- 5. In section 9 (1) of the *Chiropodists Act* 1968, for paragraphs (a) and (b) substitute—
 - "(a) holds a prescribed degree, diploma or other qualification; or".

Repeal of section 21 (g)

6. In section 21 of the Chiropodists Act 1968, paragraph (g) is repealed.
