# A BILL

to amend the Cattle Compensation Act 1967 and for other purposes

## Cattle Compensation (Amendment) Act 1991

The Parliament of Victoria enacts as follows:

#### 1. Purpose

The purpose of this Act is to increase the maximum amount of compensation payable under the Cattle Compensation Act 1967.

2. Commencement

- (1) Subject to sub-section (2), this Act comes into operation on the day on which it receives the Royal Assent.
- (2) Section 4 is deemed to have come into operation on 9 May 1989.
