## A BILL

to amend the **Cattle Compensation Act 1967** and for other purposes

### **Cattle Compensation (Amendment) Act 1991**

**The Parliament of Victoria enacts as follows:**

#### **1. *Purpose***

5 The purpose of this Act is to increase the maximum amount of compensation payable under the **Cattle Compensation Act 1967**.

#### **2. *Commencement***

- 10 (1) Subject to sub-section (2), this Act comes into operation on the day on which it receives the Royal Assent.
- (2) Section 4 is deemed to have come into operation on 9 May 1989.

**3. Compensation**

In section 5 (1) of the **Cattle Compensation Act 1967**, for “\$700” substitute “\$1000 or, if a greater amount is fixed by the Governor in Council by Order published in the Government Gazette, that greater amount”.

**4. Statute law revision—amendment affecting Cattle Compensation Act**

In section 10 (5) (b) of the **Agricultural Acts (Miscellaneous Amendments) Act 1989**, for “1978” substitute “1958”.
