A BILL

to amend the *Crown Intellectual Property (Assignment) Act 1983* and for other purposes.

Crown Intellectual Property (Assignment) (Amendment) Act 1986

The Parliament of Victoria enacts as follows:

Purpose.

1. The purpose of this Act is to authorize the Treasurer to assign certain trade marks and associated rights and benefits.

5 Commencement.

2. This Act comes into operation on the day on which it receives the Royal Assent.

Amendment of Crown Intellectual Property (Assignment) Act.

3. After section 2 (c) of the *Crown Intellectual Property (Assignment) Act 1983* insert—

“and

(d) if the assignment of any other trade marks is approved by Order of the Governor in Council published in the *Government Gazette*—

- (i) the property, right, title and interest of the State of Victoria in those trade marks, whether with or without the goodwill of any business relating to or affected by the trade marks or any other property; and
- (ii) the copyright of the Crown in right of the State associated with those trade marks—”.
