to abolish grand juries, to amend the *Crimes Act* 1958 and the *Juries Act* 1967 and for other purposes.

Crimes (Grand Juries) Act 1987

The Parliament of Victoria enacts as follows:

Purpose.

1. The purpose of this Act is to abolish grand juries.

Commencement.

5 2. This Act comes into operation on the day on which it receives the Royal Assent.

Abolition of grand juries.

3. (1) Section 354 of the Crimes Act 1958 is repealed.

Transitional provision.

- 4. The repeal by this Act of section 354 of the Crimes Act 1958 does not—
 - (a) affect the operation of any order made by the Full Court under that section before the commencement of this Act; or
 - (b) prevent a grand jury from being summoned, sworn and acting under such an order; or
 - (c) affect any indictment resulting from the deliberations of the grand jury.
