A BILL

to regulate weapons other than firearms, to repeal the *Prescribed Weapons Act* 1989, to amend the *Crimes Act* 1958, the *Firearms Act* 1958, the *Summary Offences Act* 1966 and the *Vagrancy Act* 1966 and for other purposes.

Control of Weapons Act 1989

The Parliament of Victoria enacts as follows:

Purpose

1. The purpose of this Act is to regulate weapons other than firearms.

Commencement

2. This Act comes into operation on a day or days to be proclaimed.

Definitions

- 3. In this Act—
 - "Dangerous article" means any article which—
 - (a) has been adapted or modified so as to be capable of being used as a weapon; or
 - (b) is capable of being used as a weapon to cause serious injury.
 - "Offensive weapon" means any article which is prescribed by the regulations to be an offensive weapon.

(h) In section 49 (1) (db) for "prohibited weapons" substitute "prohibited firearms".

Amendment to Summary Offences Act 1966

14. In section 60A of the *Summary Offences Act* 1966 omit "4 (k) or".

Amendment to Crimes Act 1958

15. In section 29 (3) (a) of the Crimes Act 1958 for "prohibited weapon" substitute "prohibited firearm".

Amendment to Vagrancy Act 1966

- **16.** In section 8 of the *Vagrancy Act* 1966 for paragraph (a) 10 substitute:
 - "(a) is armed, with criminal intent, with—
 - (i) a firearm or an imitation firearm within the meaning of section 29 (3) of the *Crimes Act* 1958; or
 - (ii) a prescribed weapon or an offensive weapon within the meaning of section 3 of the Control of Weapons Act 1989;".
