A BILL

to amend section 7 of the Crimes (Amendment) Act 1986.

Crimes (Unsworn Statements) Act 1990

The Parliament of Victoria enacts as follows:

Purpose

5

1. The purpose of this Act is to amend Part 2 of the *Crimes* (Amendment) Act 1986 so as to make the amendments made by that Part apply to all trials and hearings of charges that occur after the coming into operation of this Act.

Commencement

2. This Act comes into operation on the day on which it receives the Royal Assent.

10 Application of Part 2 of Crimes (Amendment) Act 1986

- 3. Section 7 of the *Crimes (Amendment) Act* 1986 is amended as No. 37/1986. follows:
 - (a) After "7." insert "(1)"; and

(b) At the end of the section insert—

"(2) Despite sub-section (1), on and from the date on which the *Crimes (Unsworn Statements) Act* 1990 comes into operation, the amendments made by this Part apply to the trial or hearing of a charge for an offence that occurs on or after that date, irrespective of when the offence was committed or alleged to have been committed.".
