**Drugs, Poisons and Controlled
Substances (Amendment) Act 1995**

The Parliament of Victoria enacts as follows:

1. *Purpose*

5 The purpose of this Act is to amend the **Drugs,
Poisons and Controlled Substances Act 1981** to
provide that interstate analysts and botanists may be
prescribed as analysts and botanists for the purposes
of section 120 of that Act.

2. *Commencement*

10 This Act comes into operation on the day on which it
receives the Royal Assent.

3. Amendment of section 120

In section 120 (6) of the **Drugs, Poisons and Controlled Substances Act 1981**—

(a) in the definition of “analyst”, after “drugs”
insert “or a person of a prescribed class
employed or approved under a prescribed law of
another State or Territory”;

(b) in the definition of “botanist”, after “**1991**”
insert “or a person of a prescribed class
employed or approved under a prescribed law of
another State or Territory”.
