To amend the Dental Technicians Act 1972 and for other purposes.

Dental Technicians (Licences) Act 1985

The Parliament of Victoria enacts as follows:

- 1. The purpose of this Act is to amend the *Dental Technicians Act* 1972—
 - (a) to remove the limits upon the fixing of fees for licences under that Act, and
 - (b) to remove the reference to the attainment of a specified age from the qualifications for the issue of an advanced dental technician's licence; and
 - (c) to increase the penalties for offences under that Act.

Commencement.

- 2. This Act comes into operation on the 28th day after the day on which it receives the Royal Assent.

3. In this Act the Dental Technicians Act 1972 is called the Principal Act.

Removal of provisions relating to maximum licence fees.

4. In sections 11 (1), 11 (2), 26 (1) and 26 (2) of the Principal Act the expression "which shall not exceed \$15" (wherever occurring) is repealed.

Removal of reference to age in qualifications for advanced dental technician's licence.

5. Section 21 (a) of the Principal Act is repealed.

Increase in penalties.

- 6. The Principal Act is amended as follows:
 - (a) In sections 15 (d) and 32 (d) for the expression "in the case of a first offence \$500 and in the case of a subsequent offence \$1000" (wherever occurring) there is substituted the expression "20 penalty units"; and

(b) In section 34 (1) for the expression "\$2000" there is substituted the expression "40 penalty units".
