Government Employee Housing Authority (Amendment) Act 1995

The Parliament of Victoria enacts as follows:

1. *Purpose*

The purpose of this Act is to make further provision
for the disposal of property by the Government
Employee Housing Authority.

2. *Commencement*

This Act comes into operation on the day on which it
receives the Royal Assent.

3. *Principal Act*

In this Act, the **Government Employee Housing Authority Act 1981** is called the Principal Act.

4. *Amendment of section 13*

In section 13 of the Principal Act, for sub-section (3) **substitute—**

“(3) The Authority may sell, let or otherwise dispose of any land, house or other real or personal property vested in or acquired by it for such price or rent, and on such terms and conditions, as it thinks fit.”.
