A BILL

to amend section 156 of the *Liquor Control Act 1968* and for other purposes.

Liquor Control (Vigneron's Licences) Act 1985

The Parliament of Victoria enacts as follows:

Purpose.

1. The purpose of this Act is to abolish the *ad valorem* duty on vigneron's licences.

5 Commencement.

2. This Act comes into operation on 1 January 1986.

Amendment of *Liquor Control Act 1968*.

3. For sub-sections (3) and (3A) of section 156 of the *Liquor Control Act 1968* substitute—

10 “(3) The fee for a vigneron's licence is \$150.”.
