## A BILL

*for*

An Act to make miscellaneous amendments to the **National Parks Act 1975** and for other purposes.

### **National Parks (Miscellaneous Amendments) Act 1990**

**The Parliament of Victoria enacts as follows:**

#### **1. *Purpose***

The purpose of this Act is to amend the **National Parks Act 1975**—

- 5           (a) to amend the regulation-making powers; and  
             (b) to alter the descriptions of certain parks.

#### **2. *Commencement***

This Act comes into operation on the day on which it receives the Royal Assent.

### 3. *Principal Act*

In this Act the **National Parks Act 1975** is called the Principal Act.

### 4. *Amendment of regulation-making powers*

In section 48 of the Principal Act, for sub-sections (2) and (3) **substitute**— 5

“(2) The regulations—

- (a) may be of general or limited application; and
- (b) may differ according to differences in time, place or circumstances; and 10
- (c) may leave any matter to be approved or determined by the Minister or Director; and
- (d) if the regulation is in respect of a toll, fee or charge, may provide for discounts, deductions, concessions or exemptions from the toll, fee or charge. 15

(3) Despite sub-section (2) (c), the regulations may not empower the Minister or Director to increase any toll, fee or charge or to introduce any new toll, fee or charge.” 20

### 5. *Amendments to Schedule Two*

(1) In part 3 of Schedule Two to the Principal Act—

- (a) for “1230 hectares” **substitute** “1522 hectares”; and
- (b) **omit** “or bordered green or coloured yellow”; and
- (c) for “N.P. 22/2” **substitute** “N.P. 22/3”. 25

(2) In part 13 of Schedule Two to the Principal Act for “N.P. 9/1” **substitute** “N.P. 9/2”.

(3) In part 29 of Schedule Two to the Principal Act—

- (a) for “954 km<sup>2</sup>” **substitute** “987 km<sup>2</sup>”; and
- (b) **omit** “or coloured yellow”; and 30
- (c) for “NP 31/2” **substitute** “N.P. 31/3”.

(4) In part 35 of Schedule Two to the Principal Act—

(a) for “351 km<sup>2</sup>” **substitute** “388 km<sup>2</sup>”; and

(b) **omit** “or coloured yellow”; and

(c) for “NP 43/1” **substitute** “N.P. 43/2”.

5 (5) In part 36 of Schedule Two to the Principal Act—

(a) for “251 km<sup>2</sup>” **substitute** “256 km<sup>2</sup>”; and

(b) for “NP 92” **substitute** “N.P. 92/1”.

(6) In part 37 of Schedule Two to the Principal Act, after paragraph (b) **insert**—

10 “; and

(c) in the area marked A13B on the plan in the Schedule to the **National Parks (Miscellaneous Amendments) Act 1991**, until 1 July 1993.”.

## 6. *Amendments to Schedule Two B*

15 (1) In part 13 of Schedule Two B to the Principal Act—

(a) for “6300 hectares” **substitute** “6900 hectares”; and

(b) for “and Egerton” **substitute** “, Egerton and Whirrakee”; and

(c) **omit** “or bordered green or coloured yellow”; and

20 (d) for “N.P. 72” **substitute** “N.P. 72/1”.

(2) In part 17 of Schedule Two B to the Principal Act—

(a) for “13 340 hectares” **substitute** “141 km<sup>2</sup>”; and

(b) for “N.P. 89” **substitute** “N.P. 89/1”.

(3) In part 26 of Schedule Two B to the Principal Act—

25 (a) for “PADDY RANGES” **substitute** “PADDYS RANGES”; and

(b) for “N.P. 96” **substitute** “N.P. 96/1”.

7. Rights to cease

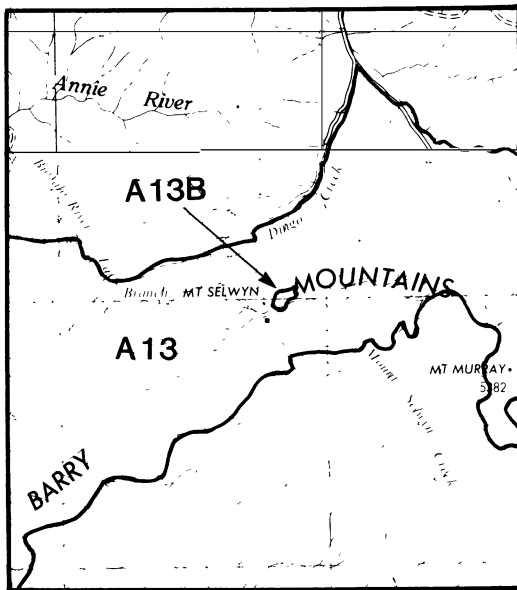
The lands delineated by a green border in the plans referred to in parts 29, 35 and 36 of Schedule Two and part 17 of Schedule Two B to the Principal Act as amended by this Act cease to be reserved forest.
