Public Contracts (Repeal) Act 1986

The Parliament of Victoria enacts as follows:

Purpose.

1. The purpose of this Act is to repeal the *Public Contracts Act* 1958.

5 Commencement.

2. This Act comes into operation on the day on which it receives the Royal Assent.

Repeal.

3. The Public Contracts Act 1958 is repealed.

10 Consequential amendments.

4. The Acts mentioned in the Schedule are amended to the extent shown in the Schedule.
