to amend the *Port of Melbourne Authority Act 1958* and for other purposes.

Port of Melbourne Authority (Amendment) Act 1987

The Parliament of Victoria enacts as follows:

Purpose.

1. The purpose of this Act is to add a member from Westernport to the Port of Melbourne Authority.

5 Commencement.

2. This Act comes into operation on a day to be proclaimed.

Additional Member.

3. In section 4 (2) of the *Port of Melbourne Authority Act 1958* for “six” substitute “seven”.

4. After section 7 of the *Port of Melbourne Authority Act 1958* insert—

Westernport representative.

“7A. One other of the members other than the chairman must be a person who is associated with the development of the Port of Westernport or is identified with activity related to that port.”. 5
