## A BILL

for

An Act to amend the Police Offences Act 1958 with respect to restricted publications, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Victoria in this present Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows (that is 5 to say):

- 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the Police Offences (Restricted short title. Publications) Act 1980.
- (2) In this Act the Police Offences Act 1958 is called the Principal Act.
