A BILL

To authorize Expenditure on Public Works and Services and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Victoria in this present Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows (that is to say):

1. This Act may be cited as the *Public Works and Services Act* 1980. Short title.

2. From the Works and Services Account there may be issued and applied the several amounts specified in the Table to this Act in the column headed "Proposed Provision" for the respective works and purposes specified opposite thereto not exceeding \$457 185 000 in all. Issue and application of money from Works and Services Account for public works.

3. Before any monthly distribution pursuant to Division 1 of Part V. of the *Marine Act* 1958 is made from the Pilots Salary Fund to pilots licenced for Port Phillip there shall be deducted from the amount to be so distributed and paid to the Treasurer of Victoria such sum as he certifies is necessary to meet interest and redemption payments in respect of the advance by way of loan referred to in Item 146 of the Table to this Act.

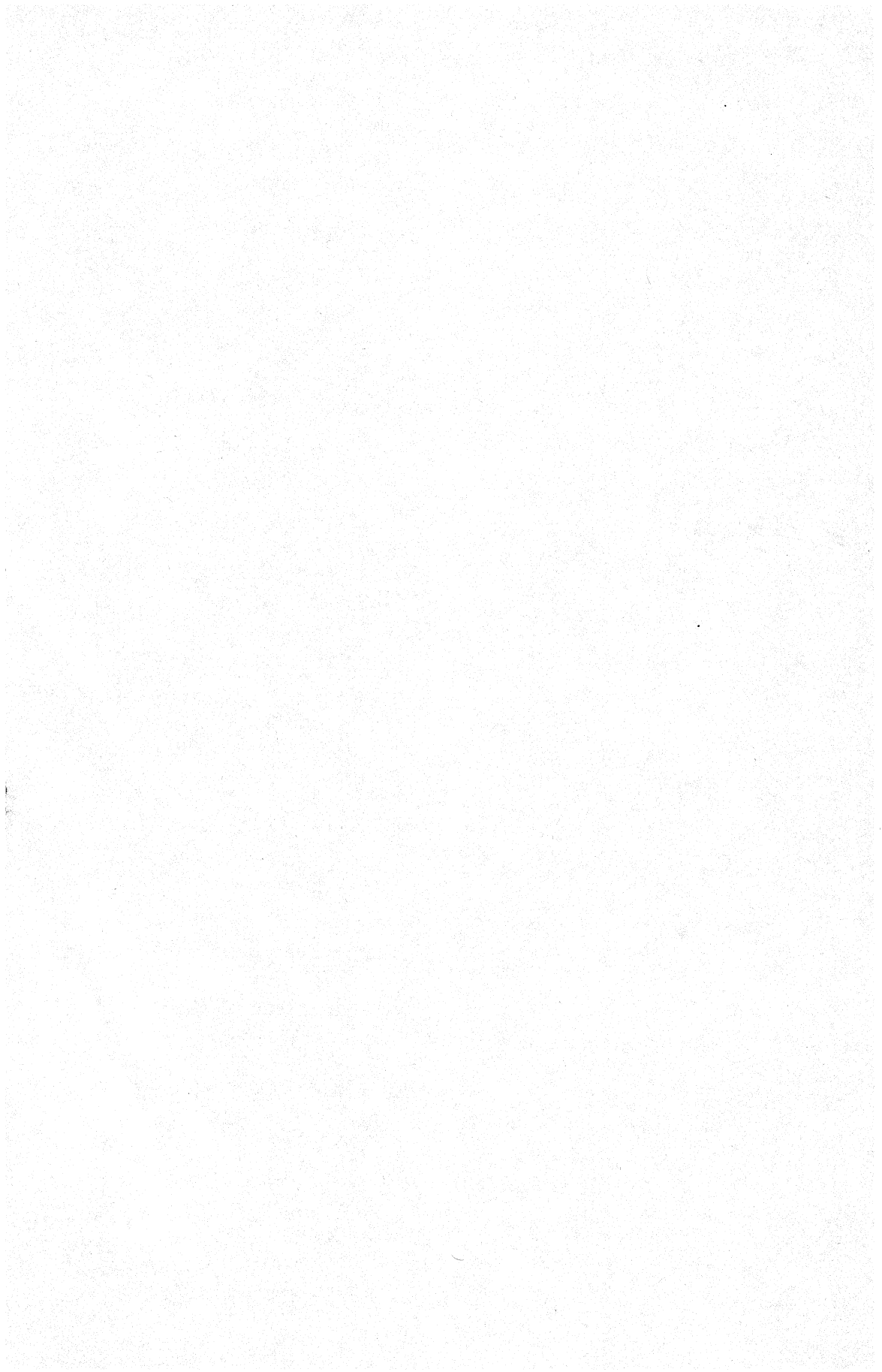
