A BILL

for

An Act to continue in operation certain sections of the *Road Safety Act 1986*

Road Safety (Photographic Detection Devices) Act 1988

The Parliament of Victoria enacts as follows:

Purpose.

- 5 1. The purpose of this Act is to continue in operation the sections of the *Road Safety Act 1986* that relate to offences detected by photographic detection devices.

Commencement.

2. This Act comes into operation on the day on which it receives the Royal Assent.

Principal Act.

- 10 3. In this Act, the *Road Safety Act 1986* is called the Principal Act.

Repeal of expiry provisions.

- 15 4. (1) Section 66 (6) of the Principal Act is repealed.
(2) Section 67 (8) of the Principal Act is repealed.
(3) In section 80 of the Principal Act—
(a) omit “(1)”; and
(b) sub-section (2) is repealed.
