

An Act to amend the Victorian Arts Centre Act 1979 and for other purposes.

Victorian Arts Centre (Amendment) Act 1994

The Parliament of Victoria enacts as follows:

1. Purpose

The purpose of this Act is to provide further for the Trust to enter into joint venture agreements for the provision of ticketing, inventory management of admissions, marketing and related services.

2. Commencement

This Act comes into operation on the day on which it receives the Royal Assent.

Section headings appear in bold italics and are not part of the Act. (See Interpretation of Legislation Act 1984.)

3. Principal Act

In this Act, the Victorian Arts Centre Act 1979 is called the Principal Act.

4. Functions of the Trust

In section 5 of the Principal Act, after paragraph (f) insert—

- ": and
- (g) to carry on, whether within or outside Victoria, whether alone or in association with any other person or persons and whether or not in relation to the Centre, a business of providing ticketing, inventory management of admissions, marketing and related services."

5. Powers of the Trust

In section 6 (2) of the Principal Act, for paragraph (ca) substitute—

"(ca) with the consent in writing of the Minister after consultation with the Treasurer, to be a member of a body corporate, association, partnership, trust or other body;

(cb) with the consent in writing of the Minister after consultation with the Treasurer, to form, or participate in the formation of, a body corporate, association, partnership, trust or other body;

(cc) with the consent in writing of the Minister after consultation with the Treasurer, to enter into a joint venture with another person or other persons;

(cd) to do all things necessary or convenient to be done for, or in connection with, a joint venture

in the performance of the functions of the Trust;".
