A BILL

to make ancillary provisions for certain works and purposes for the
financial year 1991–92

Works and Services (Ancillary Provisions, 1991–92, No. 1) Act 1991

The Parliament of Victoria enacts as follows:

1. Purpose

5 The purpose of this Act is to make ancillary provisions
for certain works and purposes for the financial year
1991–92.

2. Commencement

This Act comes into operation on 1 July 1991.

3. Definitions

In this Act—

10 **“Program”** means a Program shown in the Table;

“Table” means the Table to section 4 of the *Supply
(1991–92, No. 1) Act 1991*;

“Works” means the construction, replacement, renovation, renewal, protection, development or surveying of and maintenance, alterations or improvements to buildings, structures, forests, waterworks or other properties, the purchase of land, buildings or property and the provision, alteration etc. of furniture, fittings, plant, machinery, equipment, tools and vehicles and expenditure incidental to those activities.

4. *Education and Training* 10

Any sums specified for expenditure on works and services in Programs 292, 293, 294, 296, 297 and 298 may be applied in payments to school or college councils or with the authority of such councils to contractors on their behalf or to municipalities and other bodies to enable payments to be made in respect of approved works to the extent that amounts have become due and payable in respect of those works. 15

5. *Department of Conservation and Environment—studies, &c.*

The Department of Conservation and Environment may expend such part of the sum specified for expenditure on works and services in Program 215 as is determined by the Treasurer for waste water treatment, other studies and works. 20

6. *Murray-Darling Basin Commission* 25

- (1) The Treasurer may determine that part of the sum specified for expenditure on works and services in Program 218 may be expended under and pursuant to the *Murray-Darling Basin Commission Act 1982*.

- (2) Any sum so expended shall be charged to the Capital Expenditure Borne by the State Account and the liability therefor shall be borne by the State accordingly.
