## Beer Prices Regulation (Temporary Provisions) Bill 1983

## **NOTES ON CLAUSES**

Clause 1 contains the short title and commencement provisions.

Clause 2 provides that the "Commissioner" shall be the Prices Commissioner appointed under the Fuel Prices Regulation Act 1981.

Clause 3 provides that the Commissioner may by order published in the Government Gazette fix the maximum brewery price for beer.

Clause 4 makes it an offence for any person to sell beer at a price greater than the maximum price.

Clause 5 provides for the reading together of the Bill and the Fuel Prices Regulation Act 1981.

Clause 6 provides that the Act will cease to apply on 30 June 1984 or on such earlier date as is specified in a resolution passed by each House of Parliament and makes section 7 (2) of the Acts Interpretation Act 1958 applicable on the expiry of the Bill.
